

PITCHPETS.COM “FARM” 2020

Course Transcript

This Course is intended for use with verbal toddlers through age 6.

Its objective is to teach perfect pitch while the developing brain permits.

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FRONTGATE (WELCOME)

1. Intro: Welcome children to our pitch pets farm where each of the 12 animals have a name, a sign and their very own *sound!* We're going to meet each animal, learn its sign, and its *sound* so we can play games with them including their favorite game: hide and seek.

2. Sensitive Ears: Did you know that animals have very sensitive ears? You'll want to be *very quiet* so you don't scare the animals. So listen carefully, make their sign, and then sing their name.

3. Finger Signs: Hi children. Let me tell you how to make some of our pitch pets signs with our fingers numbered 1 through 5 beginning with the thumb.

MEET THE FAMILY (BEGINNER)

4. Sign Set 1: First the **CAT:** Press 1 and 2 together with 3, 4, and 5 up and loose. Pretend that you're pulling your whiskers out from your upper lip twice.

Now the **FROG:** Place your fist under your chin. Quickly flick 2 and 3 twice like a frog does when he catches a fly.

For the **ANT:** Put your palm in front of your nose with 1, 4 and 5 closed. Then wiggle 2 and 3 in front of your eye like and ant moves its feelers.

Last is the **DOVE**: Place your open hand on your chest then lift it off as you close your fingers. Then connect both wrists opening and wiggling all your fingers as they fly up and to the side.

5. Pet Set 1: Cat; Frog; Cat; Frog; Frog; Cat; Ant; Dove; Ant; Dove; Dove; Ant. Cat; Frog; Ant; Dove; Dove; Ant; Frog; Cat.

6. Sign set 2: Here are some more pitch pet signs.

First is the **COW**: Close 2, 3 and 4 with 1 and 5 out. Now place your thumb up on the side of you head and drop your pinky twice.

Next is the **GOAT**: Keep 1, 4, and 5 closed with your palm in. Flick 2 and 3 to the side from your forehead and then your chin.

For the **APE**: put both elbows out with your palms up and fingers spread. Make 3 small up and down motions.

Last is the **ELK**: Open both hands with your fingers up and place your thumbs on the upper sides of your head. Move your hands out and up like antlers.

7. Pet Set 2: Cow, Goat, Cow, Goat, Goat, Cow. Ape, Elk, Ape, Elk, Elk, Ape. Cow, Goat, Ape, Elk, Elk, Ape, Goat, Cow.

8. Sign set 3: Our last set of sings begins with

The **DOG**: Close 4 and 5 and connect 2 and 3. Raise your hand and touch your thumb as you signal “come.”

Next is the **GOOSE**: Close 4 and 5 and connect 2 and 3 with your thumb loose and down. Point forward from your chin and close three times like a beak.

Now the **BEE**: Touch the tips of 1 and 2 with 3, 4 and 5 open. Pull from your cheek then move your flat palm down with all your fingers open.

Our last pet is the **FOX**: Touch the tips of 1 and 2 with 3, 4 and 5 up and loose. Spin your wrist closing all except 2 which is up and curved.

9. Pet Set 3: Dog, Goose, Dog, Goose, Goose, Dog. Bee, Fox, Bee, Fox, Fox, Bee. Dog, Goose, Bee, Fox, Fox, Bee, Goose, Dog.

10. Friends Game Intro: At our pitch pets farm the animals have coupled up to play a friend's game.

11. Friends Game 1:

(D# and C): Dove and Cat are good friends. Who are they? You are Dove and Cat.

(E and C#): Elk and Cow are good friends. Who are they? You are Elk and Cow.

(F and D): Fox and Dog are good friends. Who are they? You are Fox and Dog.

12. Night Game 1 Intro: When its dark at night can you tell which animals are there just by their sound? Now close your eyes and hear if you can recognize our pets as they play.

13. Night Game 1:

(D# and C): Can you hear us? Sounds like ____ and _____. I hear Dove and Cat.

(E and C#): Can you hear us? Sounds like _____ and _____. I hear Elk and Cow.

(F and D): Can you hear us? Sounds like _____ and _____. I hear Fox and Dog.

(A and F#): Ant and Frog are good friends. Who are they? You are Ant and Frog.

(A# and G): Ape and Goat are good friends. Who are they? You are Ape and Goat.

(B and G#): Bee and Goose are good friends. Who are they? You are Bee and Goose.

15. Name Game 2 Intro: Close your eyes and try to identify our couples just by their sound.

16. Name Game 2:

(A and F#): Can you hear us? Sounds like ____ and _____. You are Ant and Frog.

(A# and G): Can you hear us? Sounds like ____ and _____. You are Ape and Goat.

(B and G#): Can you hear us? Sounds like ____ and _____. You are Bee and Goose.

17. Hide 1 Intro: Now some of the animals will scatter and find new friends to play hide and seek.

18. Hide 1:

(C and A): Cat and Ant are hiding. Where are they? Hide now Cat and Ant.

(C# and A#): Cow and Ape are hiding. Where are they? Hide now Cow and Ape.

(D and B): Dog and Bee are hiding. Where are they? Hide now Dog and Bee.

19. Seek 1 Intro: Let's see if we can find them. Ready or not, here we come.

20. Seek 1:

(C and A): Can you find us? You are ____ and _____. I found Cat and Ant.

(C# and A)#: Can you find us? You are ____ and _____. I found Cow and Ape.

(D and B): Can you find us? You are ____ and _____. I found Dog and Bee.

21. Hide 2 Intro: OK other animals; it's your turn to couple up and hide.

22. Hide 2:

(F# and D#): Frog and Dove are hiding. Where are they? Hide now Frog and Dove.

(G and E): Goat and Elk are hiding. Where are they? Hide now Goat and Elk.

(G# and F): Goose and Fox are hiding. Where are they? Hide now Goose and Fox

23. Seek 2 Intro: Let's go find them. Ready or not, here we come.

24. Seek 2:

(F# and D#) Can you find us? You are ____ and _____. I found Frog and Dove.

(G and E) Can you find us? You are ____ and _____. I found Goat and Elk.

(G# and F) Can you find us? You are ____ and _____. I found Goose and Fox.
